



RCMP Youth SQUAD Program Other INFORMATION and REQUIREMENTS

The RCMP Youth Squad Program introduces students in Grades 10-12 to various facets of policing and emergency services. Students have an opportunity to meet police officers working in specialized units, learn about the day-to-day work they perform and meet police officers in the following units:

- Traffic Section
- Police Dog Section
- Drug Section
- Emergency Response Team
- Forensic Services

Other agencies participating in this program are; the Canadian Military, BC Ambulance Service and Richmond Fire Rescue.

The program is a total of 20 hours. Accepted students are expected to participate in all of the evening sessions.

The application package will ask students to provide the following documentation:

- RCMP Youth Squad Program Application form
- Richmond School District Consent for Release of Confidential Information (SA-60)
- School District No. 38 (Richmond) Non Standard Work-Site Agreement
- SD38 Disclosure of Personal Information/Technology Use Responsibilities Form
- Richmond School District Emergency/Medical Information Form
- RCMP Police Observer Program Waiver
- RCMP Criminal Record and Police Indices Check. (hand in signed form with package)
- 250 word essay outlining why you wish to attend this program and what you hope to gain.
- Cheque to cover program costs – payable to The City of Richmond. (If not selected, cheque will be returned to student.)

****Note: This is not the RCMP Youth Academy Program. The Academy runs for a week in the Spring. Applications for this are available later in the school year.**
