Program Description

This Foundation Plumbing program, offers students an opportunity to receive Level 1 technical training in this trade. Students will apply their knowledge by learning how to plan, design, install & service various types of piping systems. They also learn how to use industry specific tools and machinery.

Upon successful completion of this program, students will achieve technical training credit for the first of four levels towards Red Seal certification and can seek employment as apprentices.

Program Requirements

- English 11 or Comm 11
- Any Math 11
- Physically able (move heavy equipment, work in tight spaces)
- Successful result on math assessment
- Relevant ADST (Tech Ed.) course work is an asset

Program Detail

- Pass ITA exam and course work (blended) and earn Level 1 technical training certification (Certificate of Completion) + credit for 375 work-based hours
- Receive 16 credits (4 courses) at Grade 12 level

Tuition and Fees

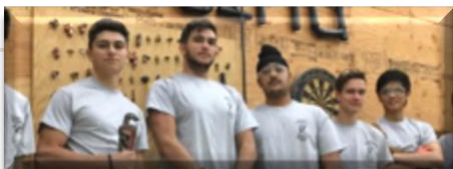
- Tuition is paid by SD38 - **Students save more than \$2800** on regular PIC tuition
